Tuesday 5 September:

D Kennet & Avon Canal

Walk along canal past Widcombe Flight to Sydney Gardens, Claverton Pump (will not be working due to cracks), Brassknocker Basin (lunch) for walk to Dundas Aqueduct, Saltford Brass Mill.

Ferry Lane to Claverton will involve a ten minute walk but a car will be available to ferry those who need it.
